

3344-16-02 Classroom and related responsibilities

- (A) Examination and reades
 - (1) Dates for final examinations are posted on the university registrars website. All final examinations shall be administered during the period assigned by the versity registrar and shallollow the approved timeschedule as designated by the administration. In the event of a class without a final exam, a class session sballheld during the scheduled final exam period. Laboratory, thesis, internship, field work and independent study courses are excluded from this requirement. In classes where takehome finals are assigned, the tarkeme examination is due on the day and time of the regularly scheduling.
 - (2) Faculty shall be required to subnominates at the end of a term. Faculty teaching on-beundred and two-beundred level courses shall also make every reasonable effort to submit mid-term grades for freshmen enrolled in such courses. Final grades soluted be submitted within forty eight hours of the end of the examination, but not later that t deadline established by the regists and fice.
 - (3) One copy of each styles shall be filed with thehair and supplied to the students at the start of classes syllabus shall contain grading and pedagogical guidelines as well as course content and assignments. A copy of the final exam
