Cleveland State University Distinguished Emeritus Faculty Honorary Degree Nomination Guidelines

Cleveland State University will recognize its accomplished emeritus faculty through awarding of a Distinguished Emeritus Faculty Homany Degree. The Homany Degree is the highest awarding of the Homany Degree recognizes amindividual of distinction, one who has achieved the highest level of skill and competence in his/her discipline. The awarding of an Homany Degree is also an expression of the ideals of the University reflected in the recipients who are awarded, Milinging homorand distinction to the University, as well as the individual.

Humany degrees are typically avaided at the May and December commencement ceremonies and occasionally, at the Cleveland Marshall College of Law Commencement. No more than three humany degrees should be avaided at each of the commencement ceremonies. One humany degree may be avaided to a distinguished emeritus faculty annually.

Suggested cardidates to receive a Distinguished Emeritus Faculty Hororary Degree from Cleveland State University are those with the following characteristics:

Has attained CSU emeritus faculty status

Has extraordinary achievements inteaching research and service at Cleveland State University
